Michael Wile, Manager, Corporate Real Estate advised that industrial land tends to be less valuable and HRM would like to match the amount of employment lands with the population growth in the future. HRM would like the industrial park to be as eco-friendly as possible.

The Committee noted that environmental impacts should be carefully considered given its close proximity to the Western Common, and that maintaining as much of the existing vegetation as possible should be a priority.

Douglas Reid, Real Property Planning Coordinator, Parks & Recreation, provided some additional context with respect to the June 5, 2018 report to Regional Council and stated updates can be provided to the Committee as things move along.
