9.1.1 Federation of Canadian Municipalities Site Visit

Marion Currie, Program Manager provided information regarding the facilities to be used during the FCM 2018 Conference including the Nova Centre and Cunard Centre. Committee members suggested that a tour in late September would be of value.

The Committee offered suggestions for the conference including:

- Canada flags on stage for national anthem;
- Organized coat check;
- Strong rural component;
- Adequate transportation, load and go;
- Be mindful of prominent advertising on materials such as lanyards;
- Consider HRP mounted units near the FCM meeting space; and
- Outdoor activities for delegates.

Marion Currie provided an overview of the responsibilities of the municipality, which includes:

- Mayor's social reception on Friday;
- Gala dinner Sunday evening;
- Study Tour program;
- Companion program;
- Transportation and logistics requirements, considering the likelihood that hotels in both Halifax and Dartmouth will be used;
- Arranging volunteers for the conference.

Currie also noted that the municipality has received \$50,000 from the provincial government for the conference. Responding to questions from Committee members, Currie agreed to investigate the number of hotel rooms available and determine the price for conference Pins.
