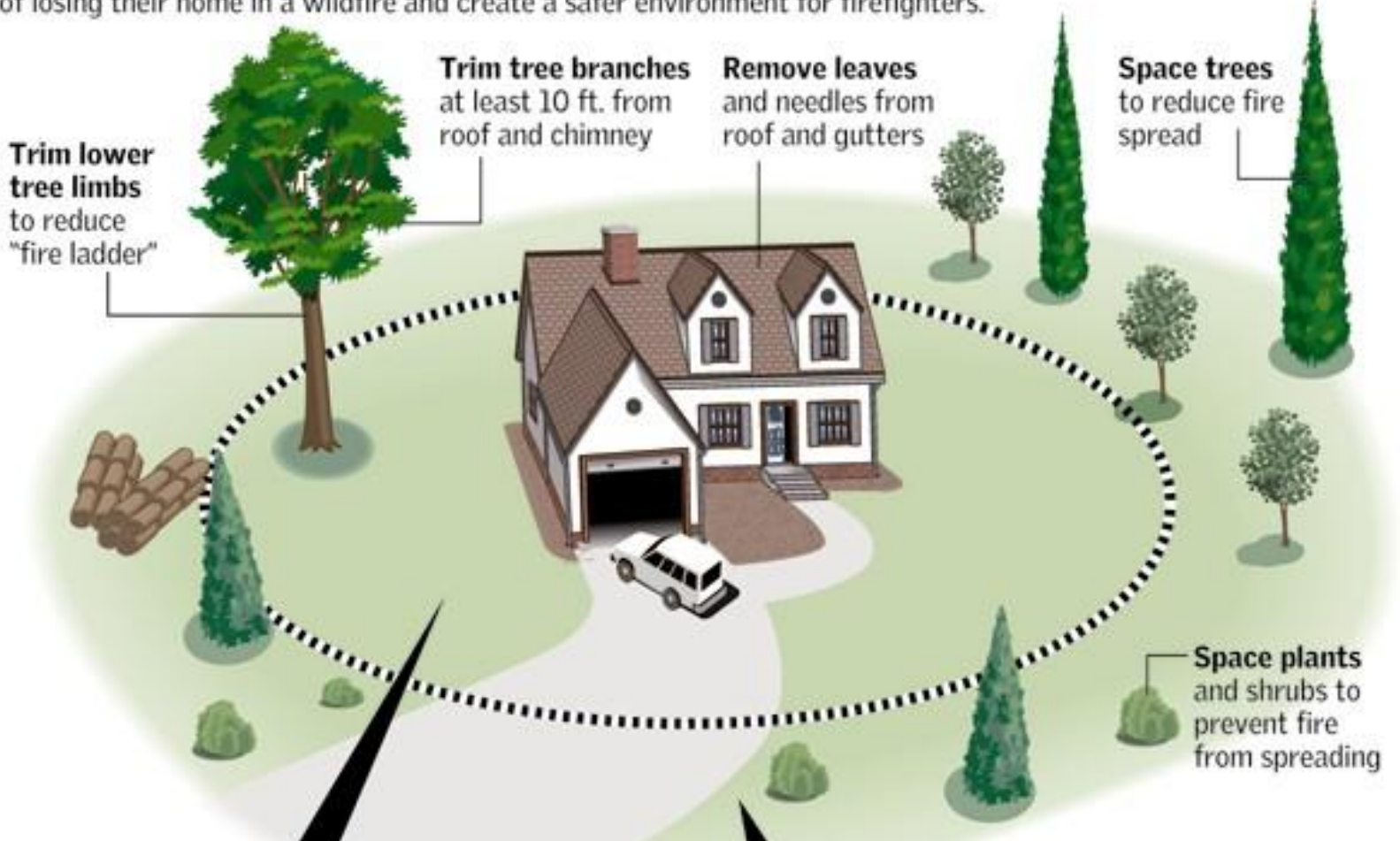


Protecting your home from wildfires

By eliminating dry brush and properly spacing plants, homeowners can reduce the risk of losing their home in a wildfire and create a safer environment for firefighters.

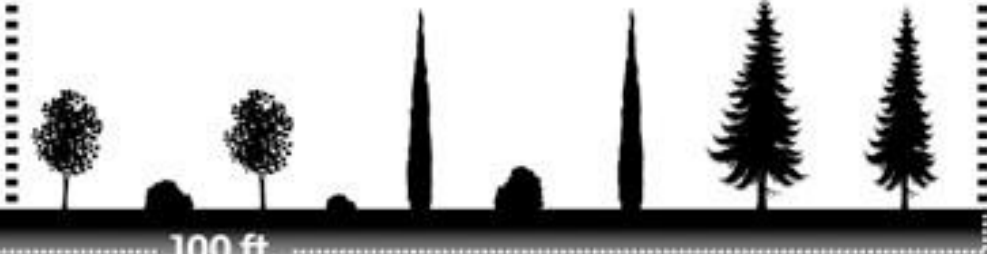


Clean green zone: 30 ft.

- Area within 30-foot radius of home requires greatest reduction in flammable vegetation.
- Remove all debris and fire-hazard materials such as wood and lumber.

Reduced fuel zone: Next 70 ft.

- For the next 70 ft. or to the property line, create horizontal and vertical spacing between plants, according to steepness of slope and size of trees or plants.
- Remove all plants beneath large trees to eliminate "vertical fire ladder."
