

# BACKGROUND

## RECREATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE CANADA (RInC) PROGRAM Sport Court Upgrades - Halifax Regional Municipality



**Project Type:** Rehabilitation and repair of existing recreational infrastructure

**Project Detail:** These upgrades will address life cycle refurbishment of 21 multi-use sport courts (tennis, basketball, and ball hockey) in 13 locations throughout HRM. HRM has just completed an inventory and assessment of 237 sports courts across the region. The results indicate that 76 courts are in need of complete surface restoration. The estimate per court is \$35,000. Staff have estimated a cost of \$750,000 to address deficiencies for approximately 21 single sport courts by March 31, 2011.
