## **New MetroX Commuter Transit Service to Tantallon!**

- ◀ Our new MetroX service, designed with the weekday commuter in mind, will bring express transit to Park & Ride lots along 100-series highways within HRM, beginning with service to Tantallon.
- ◀ The MetroX buses are different than standard city buses; specifically built and designed with individual reclining seats and air conditioning. One wheelchair can be accommodated by a lift at the rear of each bus.
- ◀ Free designated Park & Ride lot at Hubley Centre - 185 spaces.
- ◀ While MetroX provides its passengers with a worry-free and comfortable commute downtown, MetroX is also a great way to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- ◀ Riding your bike to the MetroX station can be an option as well. Each MetroX station will feature bike racks, with bike lanes near each station. Every MetroX bus will also be equipped with a bike rack which accommodates two bicycles on a first come, first serve basis.

## Schedule Information

- ◀ Providing one-way direct service inbound on #103 to Downtown Halifax on Abermarle Street (formerly Market Street); with easy access to Scotia Square, trips beginning at 5:58 am, 6:28 am, 7:03 am, 7:35 am, and the last trip departing at 8:03 am.
- ◀ Three two-directional afternoon trips beginning at 12:30 pm, 2:00 pm and 3:25 pm from Hubley Centre to downtown.
- ◀ Peak afternoon one-way service begins from Scotia Square at 4:15 pm, 4:45 pm, 5:15 pm, 5:45 pm, and the last trip departing at 6:50 pm.
- ◀ MetroX fares reflect the premium service, with direct service to the downtown core.

### Cash Fares

- Adult \$3.25
- Child/Senior \$2.50
- Student \$3.25

### Monthly Pass

- Adult \$100
- Additional fare required with MetroPass, Upass or transfer \$1.00
- Additional fare with MetroLink passes or transfers \$0.50
