Design Review Committee

**HRM residents who are interested in sitting on the
“Design Review Committee” are invited to submit an
Expression of Interest stating interest and qualifications to serve.**

Purpose: The purpose of the Design Review Committee is to aid in the evaluation of applications for development within the downtown Halifax plan area established by the recently adopted HRM by Design Downtown Halifax Plan. The Design Review Committee will assess applications for conformity with the new Downtown Halifax Design Manual and advise municipal staff accordingly.

Membership Criteria: Design Review Committee Composition and qualifications are: four architects (one of which is to be certified in green building design and construction when possible), two landscape architects, one city planner or urban designer, one structural engineer, and one professional at large from the above mentioned professions. These nine professional members must hold a professional degree in their respective field, however a professional license is not required. Additionally there are three resident at large positions requiring no specialized training. Total membership is twelve.

Timeframe: Appointments shall be for a period of two years, with the exception that half of the original appointments (six) shall be made for a periods of one year.
