

On Wednesday, September 21 at 7:00 PM you are encouraged to attend a meeting at **Caledonia Junior High School** concerning the proposed construction of a 20,000 sq. foot Community Centre in East Dartmouth. This is an opportunity to get updated and provide feedback on the project.

Individuals and community groups have been working for many years to develop a Community Centre for our area. The plan is to build a centre that will allow the community to come together and also provide a home for a number of community groups and service providers, including the East Dartmouth Boys and Girls Club.

A group of some 20 area residents, representatives of community groups and organizations, and municipal, provincial and federal representatives came together in 2004 to move the project forward.

\$1.1M is now committed by HRM to the project, and plans call for a cost sharing with the Province and the Federal government to build a \$3.3M Community Centre next to Caledonia Junior High school. The plans call for:

- Total building size: 20,000 square feet
- Community space: Numerous meeting and activity rooms, including computer room, meeting space for adult and senior's activities, as well as private functions and rentals.
- A multi purpose room, suitable for basketball, volley ball, large public meetings, and special events such as wedding receptions.
- A full service Kitchen, suitable for catering
- Office and program space for the East Dartmouth Boys and Girls Club
- Office and program space for community health services, resource agencies, etc
