Who is eligible to vote?

Every person who (a) is of the full age of eighteen years on ordinary polling day; (b) is a Canadian citizen on ordinary polling day; and (c) has been ordinarily resident in the municipality for a period of three months immediately preceding ordinary polling day and continues to so reside.

Residents of HRM otherwise qualified to vote, but not on the final electors' list, may vote on Ordinary Polling Day or on Advance Poll Days by presenting evidence of identification and residency to the Deputy Returning Officer and by swearing to and signing an oath or affirmation.
