



## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

### **AEROTECH WWTF ENVIRONMENTAL RISK ASSESSMENT**

Sealed Request for Proposals plainly marked on the envelope “**Request for Proposals – AeroTech WWTF Environmental Risk Assessment**”, will be received by the undersigned until 3:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, February 10, 2011. A non-mandatory site visit is being held at the AeroTech Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 19, 2011.

The Halifax Regional Water Commission (Halifax Water) is soliciting proposals for engineering services to assist with the completion of an Environmental Risk Assessment (ERA) for the AeroTech WWTF including the selection of Environmental Quality Objectives (EQOs) for the Shubenacadie River Basin system (Johnson River, Soldier Lake and Miller Lake), as well as Environmental Discharge Objectives (EDOs) for the plant effluent. The work will be conducted in accordance with the protocols and procedures outlined in the Technical Supplements to the CCME national strategy document and the requirements laid out in the draft federal regulations.
