**Re: Alderney/Ochterloney/Edward Water Main Replacement Project**

Halifax Water, as part of its annual main renewal program, wishes to advise you of an upcoming project in downtown Dartmouth. In order to improve system reliability and performance, Halifax Water will be replacing the water mains on **Alderney Drive** (Park to Ochterloney), **Ochterloney Street** (Alderney to King), and **Edward Street** (Ochterloney to North). This project is being done as a joint effort with the Halifax Regional Municipality (HRM) and includes sidewalk replacement on both Alderney Drive (Park to North) and on Edward Street (Ochterloney to North), as well as a paving renewal on Edward Street. This work is proposed to start mid-September and will take approximately 10 - 12 weeks to complete.

Properties/buildings which are directly affected by this project will be placed on a temporary water supply laid above ground with individual connections to each home or business. The contractor will coordinate the temporary connections with the homeowner and businesses. Connections will be provided via your outside hose bib if available, or by a method agreed upon by the contractor and homeowner. For homes without hose bibs, the contractor will make arrangements with the homeowners to have a hose bib installed at the homeowner's convenience. In order to facilitate these connections to homes, a water main shutdown will occur. The contractor will notify homes and buildings prior to any water main shutdown.

Halifax Water recognizes that this project may cause some inconvenience for those who live and work in the area, and will be working with the selected contractor to make every effort to minimize disruption to the existing neighbourhood.
