



Public Service Announcement

Orchard Street, Bedford-Water Main Repaired

Wednesday, September 14, 2011 – Halifax Water crews have completed repairs to the 8” water main in the vicinity of Orchard St., Monarch Dr., and Basinview Dr. in Bedford.

Initial water pressure will be low as crews slowly re-pressurize the pipe, with full pressure expected later this afternoon.

Customers may initially experience discoloured water. This is not a health risk and the water is safe to drink. Water clarity should be restored later this evening or overnight.

Traffic control personnel will remain on-site until the work is fully completed to ensure smooth traffic flow. On site personnel will also maintain communication with local residents to help minimize disruption.

Motorists are asked to use alternate routes where possible, and to proceed carefully through the work zone. Motorists are also reminded that speed fines double in work zones.

We apologize for any inconvenience this emergency water main repair work may have caused.
