LOCKVIEW MACPHERSON WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY ASSESSMENT

Sealed Request for Proposals plainly marked on the envelope “Request for Proposals – Lockview MacPherson Wastewater Treatment Facility Assessment”, will be received by the undersigned until 3:00 p.m., Atlantic Daylight Time, December 21st, 2010.

Halifax Water is soliciting proposals for an assessment of the Lockview MacPherson Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). The facility was constructed in 1994 and it has a treatment capacity of 454 cubic meters per day and it serves both residential and commercial customers. The existing treatment plant processes include: grit removal, extended aeration, secondary clarification, filtration, and ultraviolet disinfection. There are several ongoing operational and maintenance issues at the plant that require review and recommendations for improved operational efficiency.
