



## **REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS**

### **INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN**

Sealed Request for Qualifications plainly marked on the envelope “Request for Qualifications – Integrated Resource Plan”, will be received by the undersigned until 3:00 p.m., Atlantic Daylight Time, Wednesday, April 27, 2011.

Halifax Water is soliciting statements of qualifications for services to assist in the development of an Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). Halifax Water intends to short-list qualified consulting teams that will be invited to submit proposals in response to the subsequent Request for Proposals call.

The IRP will involve developing a comprehensive framework and conducting scenario analysis that will identify and prioritize future capital and operational programs needed to deliver water, wastewater, and stormwater services while considering environmental, societal, and financial risks and constraints. Further, it will examine both supply-side and demand-side management options and challenges. Ultimately, the IRP will provide the long-term plan outlining the revenue requirements to support Halifax Water’s capital investments needed.
