



REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ)

Independent Review of the N-Viro Soil Amendment Process

Halifax Water is seeking to identify interested and qualified consultants for an independent review of the N-Viro Soil Amendment Process.

Consultants must submit their completed packages to the attention of Greg Rice, P.Eng., Halifax Water, 200 Bluewater Road, Suite 201, Bedford, Nova Scotia by 3:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, February 17, 2011.

All proponents are invited to respond to the RFQ, in accordance with the N-Viro Soil Amendment Class A Biosolids Study - Request for Qualifications document, dated February 2011. Once consultants have been deemed qualified, they will be invited to respond to a detailed Request for Proposals.

The successful candidate, selected through the Request for Proposals process, will conduct a comprehensive literature review of available information on options for biosolids processing, uses of processed biosolids products, and the environmental benefits/impacts and health implications of biosolids use. The work will also include provision of an analysis of the present methodology and product as used by Halifax Water (N-Viro high temperature lime stabilization producing the N-Viro soil amendment product for land application), in comparison with other available options.
