



## **TENDER**

### **Dunbrack Street Water Transmission Main Sliplining – Phase 2 Contract 101029**

Sealed Tenders plainly marked on the envelope “**Tender for Dunbrack Street Water Transmission Main Sliplining – Phase 2**”, will be received by the undersigned until 3:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, January 12, 2012.

The project is located in the Mainland Halifax area of Halifax Regional Municipality and includes approximately 1500 lineal metres of 1067 mm diameter coated steel water transmission main to be sliplined into an existing 1200 mm diameter concrete pressure pipe water main along Dunbrack Street. The project also includes insertion and receiving pits, joint testing, grouting of the annular space, cathodic protection, connections to existing infrastructure and pressure testing / chlorination / de-chlorination at the end of the project. The project also includes pavement re-surfacing and curb renewal along approximately 1000 metres of Dunbrack Street.

An Information Session will be held on Tuesday, December 20, at 2:00 p.m., local time, at CBCL Limited, 1489 Hollis Street, Halifax. The session will be in a question and answer format and will include a presentation by Halifax Water and the designers. Attendance is not mandatory but is encouraged.

The project documents have been prepared for use with and require being read in conjunction with the Standard Specifications for Municipal Services, available from the Joint Committee on Contract Documents, c/o SpecTech Limited, 455 Colby Drive, Dartmouth, NS.

Project Documents may be obtained from the cashier and information counter at Halifax Water, 200 Bluewater Road, Suite 201, Bedford, Nova Scotia, on payment of a non-refundable fee of \$100 (cheque or money order only), payable to Halifax Water. Tender Opening will be held at the Bluewater Road Office.

Each Tender must be accompanied by a certified cheque drawn on a Canadian Chartered Bank or Bid Bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the tender price.
