

**HALIFAX REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY  
BY-LAW NUMBER P-301  
RESPECTING THE CITY OF DARTMOUTH EMPLOYEES'  
RETIREMENT PENSION PLAN**

City Of Dartmouth By-Law P-408, the City of Dartmouth Employees' Retirement Pension Plan, as amended by Halifax Regional Municipality By-Law P-300, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 5.02 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

**5.02 Optional Retirement Date**

- (a) For Plan A Members, and Plan B Members who contribute in accordance with the provisions of Sections 4.05 (b) or 4.05 (c), but not Section 4.05(g), Optional Retirement Date means the first day of the month coincident with or next following the date on which:
  - (i) the Member attains age 55; and
  - (ii) the Member's age plus Continuous Service equals or exceeds 85.
- (b) For Plan B Members who contribute in accordance with the provisions of Section 4.05(g), Optional Retirement Date means the first day of the month coincident with or next following the date on which:
  - (i) the Member attains age 50; and
  - (ii) the Member's age plus Continuous Service equals or exceeds 80.

2. Section 7.02(a) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

**(a) Member with a Spouse**

- (i) For a Member, other than a Member who contributes in accordance with Section 4.05(g), who has a Spouse on the date on which pension payments commence, the normal form of pension is a joint and survivor pension which is payable in equal monthly instalments for the life of the Member, and payable after the Member's death to the Member's Spouse for the Spouse's life in monthly instalments and equal to 60% of the amount of the monthly pension benefit received by the Member at the time of the Member's death.

- (ii) For a Member who contributes in accordance with Section 4.05(g), who has a Spouse on the date on which pension payments commence, the normal form of pension is a joint and survivor pension which is payable in equal monthly instalments for the life of the Member, and payable after the Member's death to the Member's Spouse for the Spouse's life in monthly instalments and equal to  $66\frac{2}{3}\%$  of the amount of the monthly pension benefit received by the Member at the time of the Member's death.
