Time Capsule Update Memo

April 19/17 Meeting Discussion

The proposed contents developed at the January Time Capsule Workshop were discussed. The Committee voted on each item and responsibility for obtaining the document or item was assigned. The final content collection date was moved ahead to May 30, 2017. Some items such as Event programme and newspaper clippings will become available at a later date. After the vote, the Committee agreed to revisit the content list at the April 19/17 meeting and relate the final list back to the HAESAC legacy and guiding principles.

Digital content was discussed and HRM advised that a USB Drive or portable hard drive would be a preferred method of storing this material and could be accommodated in the new Time Capsule.

The Virtual or "live" digital content was discussed, with the idea presented that the public could provide their own Halifax Explosion content/experiences. The stories, images, etc would be captured in electronic format and be hosted on a website. Due to the considerable resources curating and managing this project would require, it is not feasible at this time.
