Requirement to fill one vacancy on the Heritage Advisory Committee as a result of the resignation of Councillor Cuttell.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Community Planning & Economic Development Standing Committee recommend that Halifax Regional Council appoint Councillor Hendsbee to the Heritage Advisory Committee for a term to November 2022 as outlined in the discussion section of this report.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

On September 14, 2021 the Clerk's Office sent out a call for expression of interest for the vacant position on the Heritage Advisory Committee (HAC) for a term to November 2022. The vacant position was previously held by Councillor Cuttell, who has resigned from HAC effective after their September meeting. The new appointment is targeted to take effect prior to HAC's meeting currently scheduled for October 27, 2021.

The Clerk's Office received one expression of interest for HAC from Councillor David Hendsbee, District 2 Preston – Chezzetcook – Eastern Shore.
