Our MetroLink system was specifically designed to encourage active living in our community. Whether it be walking, jogging or biking to our MetroLink terminals or stations, we have made the commute easier and safer for everyone.

- Our entire MetroLink fleet is equipped with bike racks. Each holding two bicycles, the racks are easy to use and safe for both the cyclist and the passengers.
- Only the MetroLink buses currently feature bike racks. Racks are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Using the bike rack is free - only your regular MetroLink fare is required.
- If you need assistance with the bike rack, please wait until passengers have boarded the bus and advise the operator.
- The bike racks will be available year round.

Loading...

Easy and Safe to use:



1. Approach the bus from the curb and indicate to the operator you will be loading your bike.



3. Place the wheels in the wheel wells. Check the markings that indicate where the front tire should be placed. The first bike should be placed nearest to the bus.



2. If the rack is closed, simply squeeze the handle up to release the latch then lower the rack completely.



4. Raise the support arm over the front tire as tightly as possible. It should never go over the frame or fender of the tire.



Unloading...



1. Prior to your stop, advise the operator you will be unloading your bike and exit from the front door.



3. Lift your bike from the rack.



2. Raise the support arm and lower away from the tire.



4. If the rack is empty, fold the rack up until it locks in place.



5. Step away from the bus curb-side and signal to the operator that you are clear.

Do's & Don'ts

- For your safety, load and unload your bike from the front or curb side of the bus
- Allow a cyclist to unload their bike before loading yours
- If the rack is full please wait for the next bus
- Only non-motorized, two-wheel bikes are allowed on the racks
