

Accessible Transportation Advisory Committee (ATAC)

ATAC is a group of volunteers that have been elected by Access-A-Bus users, to serve on the Committee for a three year term. ATAC makes recommendations to Metro Transit regarding the accessible services it provides. Metro Transit ALF, Ferries, Metro Link, Metro X, and Access-A-Bus.

Elected in 2011 (Up for Election in May - 2014)

Lawrence Wildman (3 years) (first term)

Each ATAC Member can serve a maximum of six (6) years.

The first () represents how long the Committee Member was elected for. (May be less than 3 years if elected to fill a vacancy).

The second () represents if it is the Committee Member's first or second term. First term members can be re-elected at the Annual General Meeting in May.

Second term members have to take a minimum of 1 year off, before they are eligible to re-offer for an ATAC term.
