Access-A-Bus Transit Study – Additional Public Information Sessions

Your input is critical to the success of future Access-A-Bus service delivery

Metro Transit and IBI Group will conduct two additional Public Information Sessions as a follow up to the initial information meetings, which were held in early February 2010.

We are looking for your input regarding a number of considered options or concepts. Options address alternate approaches for eligibility, trip booking, scheduling, fare policy, operations and service delivery, among others.

We need your assistance in finalizing a preferred approach (and developing an Action Plan to guide the implementation of Access-a-Bus service improvements over the next 5 and 10 year period), which will be presented in a report to Regional Council later this year.
