Mumford Terminal Bus Stop Realignment

In order to improve bus traffic flow at the Mumford Terminal, Metro Transit will be realigning its bus stops, effective Sunday, February 28, 2010.

Similar to the Barrington and Duke bus stop model, all bus stops at the Mumford Terminal will now be divided into two locations.

The first stop will be located at the lower end of the platform, while the second stop will be placed at the mid-point section of the platform, nearest the terminal building.

The first bus to arrive at either designated stop will move to the front of the platform, and any buses following will simply pull up behind the first, therefore alleviating unnecessary traffic congestion. Additionally, passengers will no longer need to leave the transit platform to board.

The following routes will be serviced at the mid-point section of the platform:

- > #1 Spring Garden, #2 Downtown, #3 Manors, #14 Leiblin Park, #20 Herring Cove, #52 Lacewood and #58 Woodlawn

The following routes will be serviced at the lower half section of the platform:

- > #2 Wedgewood, #4 Rosedale, #5 Springvale, #6 Stonehaven, #9 Barrington, #15 Purcells Cove & Bayers Rd, #19 Greystone, #20 Downtown, #23 Timberlea & Downtown

No route or schedule adjustments will be required in order to implement this new bus stop realignment.
