SUPPORTING INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

Content of Application, as defined by S. 5(4) of HRM By-law H-500 Heritage Conservation District (Barrington Street) By-law.

- Site Plan showing the property boundaries and location of the proposed development
- Elevation drawings, drawn to scale, to illustrate the architectural design, dimensions, materials and colour of the proposed development
- Where an application is for an **alteration** to an existing building or structure, it shall include "before and after" drawings, sketches or photographs to illustrate both the existing situation and the proposed alteration
- Where an application is for **demolition or removal** of a building or structure, the application shall include:
 - An explanation of the reasons for the proposed demolition or removal and the alternatives to demolition or removal that may be available.
 - A concept plan for a replacement building, with elevation drawings drawn to scale showing proposed height, facade design, and materials, including an elevation drawing or photo montage of the entire block showing the proposed replacement building in the context of all other buildings in the streetscape
 - Payment of the required fees
 - Agreement from the owner to place a sign on the property notifying the public of the demolition application.
