### PROPOSAL INFORMATION

**APPLICANT:** Halifax Regional Municipality

**REQUEST:** To amend By-law S-800, the Temporary Sign By-law.

**PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION:** The Temporary Sign By-law requires the licensing of temporary signs for private property and within HRM rights-of-way, and provides a differentiation between permanent signage such as billboards and fascia signs and signage of a temporary nature including mobile signs, posters sandwich boards, banners and inflatable signs.

In the interest of continued improvement of the administration of By-law S-800, staff are reviewing issues including:

- the duration of sign licences
- separation distances between signs; and
- architectural sign requirements.

Staff will be present to provide information and solicit input from the public on the proposed amendments.

The public information meeting will provide area residents with information regarding the proposed amendments, the amendment process, as well as provide an opportunity for staff to receive comments regarding the proposed amendments for inclusion in a recommendation report to Halifax Regional Council.
