Sackville end of trail: Fultz House

Bedford end of trail: Scott Manor House

Trail Access Points:

Bedford Access: Fish Hatchery Park, Bedford Place Mall parking lots, and Range Park.

Sackville Access: Parking on Memory Lane (behind historic Fultz House), then utilizing sidewalks across Sackville Drive to Old Sackville Road to Lynn Court intersection.

Length of Trail: 6 km

Linear or Loop Trail: Linear. Average time to walk along trail and back to parking lot approximately 4 hours return.

Surface: Crusher dust

Emergency Contact: Call 911 (pay phones available in nearby malls)

Nearest Metro Transit Stop: Cobequid Terminal Station in Sackville with Routes #66, 80, 82, 84, 85, 87, 88. (One block north of trail head) Bedford Routes #80, 82, 86, 88.
