## NOTICE TO VACATE/LEAVE AND TO REMOVE PERSONAL PROPERTY AND TEMPORARY SHELTER UNDER THE MUNICIPAL PARKS BY-LAW AND PROTECTION OF PROPERTY ACT

This Notice is to advise that the erection or placing in a park of anything for the purpose of temporary or permanent accommodation is not permitted under Halifax Regional Municipality By-Law P-600, the *Municipal Parks By-Law*.

Please be advised that this Notice serves as official notification to the occupant(s) that they must vacate the temporary shelter and remove all personal belongings. Also, those who installed the temporary shelter must remove the structure.

The Halifax Regional Municipality is providing a deadline date of **July 13**, **2021** to remove the shelter – failing which, it, and all personal items, will be removed from this location on or shortly after this date without further notice.

Failure to act in accordance with this Notice is an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars and not exceeding ten thousand dollars under the *Municipal Parks By-Law* and/or a fine of not more than five hundred dollars under the provisions of the *Protection of Property Act.* R.S.N.S., c. 363, s. 1.

Street Outreach Navigators and Housing Support Workers will continue to directly engage with occupants of the temporary shelters, prior to removal of the shelters, to offer resources and support – including a range of housing options and/or temporary accommodation.
