# 4. Case H00539: Request to Include 1245 Edward Street, Halifax, in the Registry of Heritage Property for the Halifax Regional Municipality

The following was before the Committee:

- A staff recommendation report dated June 24, 2022
- Staff presentation dated July 15, 2022
- Correspondence from Janet Morris, Heritage Trust of Nova Scotia; Diana Torbert; Peggy Walt; Mary Vingoe, Lukas Pearse and Peter Rogers

Jennifer Clarke-Hines was recused from the meeting during consideration of this item having declared a conflict interest in the matter, as they are an employee of Dalhousie University.

Seamus McGreal, Heritage Planner III, gave a presentation and answered questions for the Advisory Committee. Staff advised the Committee that staff's recommendation is to apply the heritage building evaluation criteria to the Committee's heritage assessment.

Following discussion, the Committee decided to apply the heritage building criteria in performing the heritage evaluation and provided the following scoring:

Criterion	Score Awarded
1. Age	13
2. Historical Importance	13
Significance of Builder/Architect	1
4A. Architectural Merit: Construction Type	5
4B. Architectural Merit: Style	9
5. Architectural Integrity	14
6. Relationship to Surrounding Area	9
Total	64

The Committee rendered a total score of 64 of 100 for 1245 Edward Street, Halifax.

THAT the Heritage Advisory Committee recommend that Halifax Regional Council:

- 1. Set a date for a heritage hearing to consider the inclusion of the subject property in the Registry of Heritage Property for the Halifax Regional Municipality; and
- 2. Approve the request to include 1245 Edward Street, Halifax in the Registry of Heritage Property for the Halifax Regional Municipality, as shown on Map 1 of the staff report dated June 24, 2022, as a municipal heritage property under the Heritage Property Act.
