## Invitation to the Community Liaison Group

The Penhorn area of Dartmouth has been selected to take part in Community Visioning! This area is one of three communities identified for the first phase of a region-wide, multi-year program [[www.halifax.ca/visionhrm](http://www.halifax.ca/visionhrm)] recently approved by HRM Regional Council.

Under the Regional Plan for Halifax Regional Municipality, the Penhorn area is designated an Urban Local Centre. The Regional Plan [[www.halifax.ca/regionalplanning](http://www.halifax.ca/regionalplanning)] describes community visioning as a great way to involve residents in the Plan's implementation at the local level. Visioning also builds citizen capacity such that communities can themselves undertake local initiatives.

Through Community Visioning residents of the Penhorn area will have an opportunity to work with HRM to develop a 25-year Vision and Action Plan to address a wide range of community aspirations and priorities for action. Once created, the community's Vision and Action Plan will be presented to the Regional Plan Advisory Committee, Harbour East Community Council and Regional Council. The Vision and Action Plan would become one of the frameworks used by HRM to guide future municipal budgetary and business planning decisions.

### Community Liaison Group (CLG)

Community Visioning is a community driven process. A Community Liaison Group (CLG) will be established to guide and champion the Penhorn process. The CLG will:

- lead the community visioning process
- develop guiding principles for public consultation
- ensure diverse voices in the community are represented
- facilitate the development of vision goals and objectives
- develop solutions, actions and priorities that reflect local context

The CLG does not have to be a large group, but it is very important the CLG is diverse and energetic. Each member will be asked to make a volunteer commitment of up to one year and a time commitment of about 8-10 hours each month. Once recruited, an orientation session and training will take place.

Members of the CLG for Penhorn should be able to represent the community as a whole. This means it different geographic areas, demographic characteristics, interests and points of view. The CLG is charged with making the process credible. The CLG must solicit and carefully consider a broad range of public input.

The CLG will lead the process of developing the vision, but will not censor what the community at large has expressed. CLG members will be invited to use an "appreciative lens" during the process which places emphasis on how the community can build on its strengths. Information gathered by the CLG will be used by Council to guide future decisions affecting the community.

HRM will make all effort to provide an opportunity to all residents to apply for a seat on the CLG. The CLG will not be a committee of Regional Council or Harbour East Community Council and CLG members will not be appointed by Council. A screening and telephone interview process will be used to ensure the CLG is representative of the make-up of the wider community and different interests and skill-sets are at the table.

Members of the CLG for Penhorn must be community-minded individuals who:

- are residents of the Penhorn area of Dartmouth and surrounding neighbourhoods
- must be willing to make a one year responsible volunteer commitment
- are reflective of the demographic diversity of the community (i.e. gender, age, ethnicity, socio-economic status)
- have effective interpersonal and communication skills
- have leadership potential and an active interest in the community
- have knowledge of social, health, economic and environmental issues and/or a willingness to learn
- must understand and accept the responsibility and accountability of being a member of a CLG
- must commit the time necessary for the work and training of the CLG
- have the ability to work effectively as a member of a team
- have the ability to bring a useful perspective to the deliberations and work of the group
