Naval celebrations

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the founding of Canada's navy. As the home port of the navy's East Coast fleet, Halifax has special meaning to the navy, and vice versa. From this port, convoys braved the turbulent North Atlantic during the world wars. Throughout the centennial year, the city will host special events celebrating that rich heritage. One of the biggest highlights will be the International Fleet Review from June 28 to July 2. Timed to coincide with the start of the Royal Nova Scotia International Tattoo, an armada of naval vessels from around the world will assemble in Halifax Harbour. Nothing was confirmed at press time, but rumour has it that a member of the British Royal Family will be the reviewing officer. Find more information at www.navy.forces.gc.ca/centennial/.
