The Halifax Waste/Resource Society is a citizen organization founded to monitor the HRM Solid Waste Program, with a primary focus on the Otter Lake Landfill site. Monitoring is achieved via a partnership with HRM in the formation of a Community Monitoring Committee (CMC).

The annual general meeting (AGM) is convened to provide an annual report on CMC activities and to elect the board of directors.

There are fifteen members on the CMC, nine elected by the society and six appointed by the HRM Council.

We are seeking new members, especially residents within 5 km of the landfill. All HRM residents over the age of 18 are eligible to become members of the society. A completed membership application and fee must be received by the society before May 25, 2010 to be eligible to vote at the June 14, 2010 AGM.
