- **13.1 STAFF**

13.1.1 Case 21440: Amendments to the Cole Harbour/ Westphal Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use By-law for 206 Ross Road to enable an expansion to the existing C&D Transfer Facility

The following was before Community Council:

Jennifer Chapman, Planner III provided an overview of the March 15, 2019 staff report.

THAT Harbour East-Marine Drive Community Council approve the proposed amendments to the Land Use By-law for Cole Harbour/ Westphal, as set out in Attachment B of the staff report dated March 15, 2019.

In response to questions from Community Council, Chapman advised that the intent of the site design is to move operations further away from Ross Road to alleviate queuing on the street. Further, Chapman noted that an environmental management plan is also required to protect the watercourse located on site.

Require the amending development agreement be signed by the property owners within 120 days or any extension thereof granted by Council on request of the property owner, from the date of final approval by Council and any other bodies as necessary, including applicable appeal periods, whichever is later; otherwise this approval will be void and obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.

In terms of construction delays, Totten advised that applicant has not provided a rationale, but staff would bring an update at the next meeting of Harbour-East Marine Drive Community Council.

18. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Shalom Mandaville, of Dartmouth provided commentary on the need to change the methodology employed by HRM staff in sampling lake water. Mandaville advised that a greater emphasis should be placed on fecal chloroform testing as opposed to phosphorus level testing. Mandaville provided further commentary on how municipal water is treated for consumption in HRM.

Jerri Urwood, of Cole Harbour, provided commentary on the number of development applications in the Dartmouth and Cole Harbour area and inquired as to how many are active. Urwood noted high vacancy rates across the municipality for rental units located in strip malls. Urwood noted that many of the developments are owned by large real estate investment firms, with rents that are prohibitive to many small business owners. Urwood encouraged Halifax Regional Council and staff to investigate this issue to see if regulations can be put in place to stabilize rental prices for small business owners.
