The special meeting was called to order at 1:09 p.m., and recessed at 2:25 p.m. Budget Committee reconvened at 2:45 p.m. Budget Committee adjourned at 3:46 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 1:09 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES - NONE

3. Proposed 2020/21 Budget Recast for COVID-19 Impacts

The following motion from the May 12, 2020 meeting of the Budget Committee reads:

MOVED by Deputy Mayor Blackburn, seconded by Councillor Nicoll

THAT the Budget Committee direct the Chief Administrative Officer to revise the 2020/21 Proposed Operating and Capital Budgets, as voted on by Regional Council's Committee of the Whole on Budget at their February 12, 2020 meeting, using the revisions proposed in the staff report dated May 1, 2020 as summarized in Table 3, supported by attachment C and D.

MOVED by Councillor Outhit, seconded by Councillor Austin

THAT the Budget Committee maintain funding for stump removal in the amount of \$40,000 and hand shoveling from the Snow Removal Program in the amount of \$225,000 and forward these amounts to the Parking Lot.

Budget Committee requested the motion be separated for voting purposes as per Section 90 of Administrative Order One.

MOVED by Councillor Outhit, seconded by Councillor Austin

THAT the Budget Committee maintain funding for stump removal in the amount of \$40,000 and forward this amount to the Parking Lot.

MOTION PUT AND DEFEATED. (4 in favour, 13 against)

Brad Anguish, Director of Transportation and Public Works confirmed that \$225,000 was to employee 10 seasonal staff during the winter to hand shovel areas in the core that machines could not access, such as curb cuts, crosswalk signals and work in the new bike lanes.

MOVED by Councillor Outhit, seconded by Councillor Austin

THAT the Budget Committee maintain funding for hand shoveling from the Snow Removal Program in the amount of \$225,000 and forward this amount to the Parking Lot. MOTION PUT AND PASSED. (14 in favour, 3 against)

Against: Mayor Savage, Councillors Karsten, Whitman

Anguish responded to questions on the reduction to tree planting and pruning. Anguish noted that they would provide additional details on whether the Municipality would be able to participate in the National Greening Program – Tree Canada if reductions are made to the budget.

Dave Reage, Director, Halifax Transit, spoke to the Budget Committee regarding proposed budget reduction strategies for Halifax Transit outlined in the staff report dated May 1, 2020 and answered questions.

MOVED by Councillor Hendsbee

THAT the Budget Committee maintain funding for proposed Highway 207 fixed loop service in the amount of \$200,000 and forward this amount to the Parking Lot.

There being no seconder, the **MOTION WAS LOST**.

Denise Schofield, Director, Parks and Recreation, spoke to the Budget Committee regarding proposed budget reduction strategies for Parks and Recreation outlined in the staff report dated May 1, 2020 and answered questions.
