i) Staff Presentation

Bruce Fisher, Director of Financial Policy & Planning gave a presentation on small business and commercial taxation options and responded to questions of clarification from Committee of the Whole.

ii) Public Participation

Jim Cormier, Atlantic Director, Retail Council of Canada spoke to the equitable fairness Option 2 provided.

Mathieu Maillet, Senior Director, Altus Experts Services spoke in support of a fourth commercial taxation option brought forward by Council January 14, 2022 that involves a small business application process and suggested the exclusion of new construction and major capital improvements from the program.

Tim Rissesco, Downtown Dartmouth Business Improvement District spoke in support for Option 3 and relief for small business throughout the Municipality, which aligns with the Regional Plan and Economic Strategy.

Paul MacKinnon, Downtown Halifax Business Improvement District spoke in support of Option 3, echoing points made by Rissesco.

Michell Champniss, Sackville Business Improvement District spoke in support of Option 3 and the Municipality working with the Province to make changes to legislation for small business.

Ann-Louise McKinnon, General Manager, Centrecorp Management spoke against taxing big box businesses which would impact small businesses located in the same zone and treating all businesses fairly.
