

Quick Facts

- Halifax Transit operates over 330 conventional buses & 40 Access-A-Buses out of two Transit Centres.
- Halifax Transit has 67 fixed bus routes including 14 Express routes and three Regional Express routes.
- Halifax Transit operates five harbour ferries on two ferry routes.
- On an average weekday there are over 90,000 boardings on Halifax Transit vehicles.
- Approximately 5800 passenger trips are completed by the Ferry Service each weekday.
- Halifax Transit has nearly 27 million bus passenger boardings per year.
- Since 2003, Halifax Transit has increased its service hours by over 90%.
- Halifax Transit operates over 3,900 bus trips per day.
- Halifax Transit buses travel approximately 62,000 kilometres during a weekday, that's enough to drive around the Earth and the Moon in a single day. (Distance around Earth is 40,008 km. + Distance around Moon is 11,200 km.)
- Halifax Transit buses travel nearly 20 million kilometres each year.
- The Halifax Harbour Ferry Service is the oldest, continuously operated salt water passenger ferry system in North America.
