SUBJECT: Western Common Advisory Committee – Nichols Lake Trail Update

Below is a summary of work that has been done in 2017 with respect to HRM Tender 17-010, Nichols Lake Trail Development Phase 2.

- As of November 15, 2017:
 - Approximately 1150 linear meters of trail have been cleared and grubbed. This
 represents approximately 75% of the trail proposed in Phase 2. The clearing and
 grubbing has been complete for the extension of Phase 1A to the waterfall;
 - Approximately 1100 tonnes of granular material have been placed. This represents more than half of the granular material included in Phase 2.
 - Tree cutting and clearing has started on the western section of the trail.
