Subject: Support for Anti-Poverty Strategy					
Motion for Standing Committee to consider:					
That the Standing Committee on Community Planning and Economic Development request a staff report to:					
 Evaluate a request to collaborate with United Way Halifax on an anti-poverty strategy with the aim of benefitting the economy and social fabric of the municipality; and Evaluate a request for up to \$20,000 in an in kind-contribution toward the development of an anti-poverty strategy. The in-kind contribution may include, but not be limited to, office space, printing costs and public engagement support. Reason: 					
1 in 8 residents of Halifax live in poverty, meaning that they lack the income and assets to meet their basic needs, such as food, shelter and clothing. While many of the levers impacting poverty fall outside of the municipal mandate, others, including transportation, food security, and affordable housing are within municipal control. Collaborating with United Way Halifax, and other community stakeholders, on an anti-poverty strategy promises to reduce the number of Halifax residents who live in poverty, while benefiting the economy and social fabric of the municipality.					
Outcome Sought:					
Collaboration between municipal staff and United Way Halifax on an anti-poverty strategy, and an in-kind contribution up to \$20,000 toward the development of an anti-poverty strategy.
