SUBJECT: Proposed Amendments to Administrative Order 48, Respecting the Creation

of Community Councils – Renaming District 12

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Motion approved at the April 12, 2016 Halifax Regional Council meeting

That Halifax Regional Council approve the renaming of District 12 to become Timberlea – Beechville – Clayton Park – Wedgewood and direct staff to bring forward an amendment to Administrative Order 48 to reflect the new name.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Halifax Regional Municipality Charter says

364 Part XVI of the *Municipal Government Act* applies to the Municipality.

Subsection 354 (7) is included in Part XVI of the Municipal Government Act and says

The boundaries, names and numbers of the polling districts in a municipality continue to be as they were on July 1, 1996, unless altered by the Board pursuant to this Act.

By Order of the Utility and Review Board, Re: Halifax Regional Municipality, 2012 NSUARB 228,

2. In the future, HRM may from time to time, without approval from the Board, amend the names of its polling districts, provided the district numbers are not changed.

Motion of Regional Council April 12, 2016

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council adopt the proposed amendments to Administrative Order 48, *Respecting the Creation of Community Councils*, as set out in Attachment 2 of this staff report dated April 14, 2016.

BACKGROUND

At the April 12, 2016 meeting of Regional Council, Councillor Rankin, submitted a Request for Council's Consideration form requesting that Regional Council approve the renaming of District 12 as follows: Timberlea – Beechville – Clayton Park – Wedgewood.

The reasoning for this request as outlined in the form was the current name did not provide for the distinction between the communities of Clayton Park West and Wedgewood. To better recognize these communities the proposed change removes the word "West" and adds in the community of Wedgewood.

DISCUSSION

Based on Regional Council's motion of April 12, 2016, Administrative Order 48, *Respecting the Creation of Community Councils* has been amended to reflect the new District 12 name as approved by Regional Council.

RESPECTING THE CREATION OF

COMMUNITY COUNCILS

BE IT RESOLVED AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER of the Council of the Halifax Regional Municipality as follows:

Short Title

1. This Administrative Order may be cited as Administrative Order Number 48, the Community Council Administrative Order.

Community Councils

- 2. There is hereby established the following Community Councils:
- (a) the North West Community Council for the area of the Halifax Regional Municipality that on the 6th day of November 2012 is included in:
 - i) polling district 1, Waverley Fall River Musquodoboit Valley;
 - ii) polling district 13, Hammonds Plains St. Margarets;
 - iii) polling district 14, Middle/Upper Sackville Beaver Bank Lucasville;
 - iv) polling district 15, Lower Sackville; and
 - v) polling district 16, Bedford Wentworth.
- (b) the Harbour East-Marine Drive Community Council for the area of the Halifax Regional Municipality that on the 6th day of November 2012 is included in:
 - i) polling district 2, Preston Chezzetcook Eastern Shore;
 - ii) polling district 3, Dartmouth South Eastern Passage;
 - iii) polling district 4, Cole Harbour Westphal;
 - iv) polling district 5, Dartmouth Centre; and
 - v) polling district 6, Harbourview Burnside Dartmouth East.
- (c) the Halifax and West Community Council for the area of the Halifax Regional Municipality that on the 6th day of November 2012 is included in:
 - i) polling district 7, Halifax South Downtown;
 - ii) polling district 8, Halifax Peninsula North;
 - iii) polling district 9, Halifax West Armdale;
 - iv) polling district 10, Halifax Bedford Basin West;
 - v) polling district 11, Spryfield Sambro Loop Prospect Road; and


polling district 12, Timberlea - Beechville - Clayton Park West - Wedgewood vi) with the exception of the shaded area of the Halifax Regional Municipality as shown on Schedule 1. **Powers** Subject to subsection (3) of this section, sections 29, 30 and 31 of the Halifax Regional Municipality Charter apply to each Community Council. Repealed. (2) (3)A Community Council shall create no more than two planning advisory committees. If a Community Council creates a planning advisory committee, the terms of reference for the (4) planning advisory committee be shall be as set out in Schedule 3 of this Administrative Order. (5) Nothing in this section prevents a Community Council from: limiting or adding to the duties of a planning advisory committee from those duties prescribed by section 4 of Schedule 3 of this Administrative Order; or specifying the number of community citizens that must be appointed to a planning advisory committee from a specified District or portion of a District. **Financial Consequences** A Community Council shall not pass any resolution or make any decision which could potentially result in financial consequences for the Municipality which are contrary to those which would result from a previous decision of the Regional Council, unless and until the financial consequences are presented to the Regional Council and approved by it. **Policies and Procedures** Repealed. **Effective Date** This Administrative Order comes into force December 3, 2012. 6. Meetings

- ➤ The Planning Advisory Committee shall meet at least once per month or as required to conduct business of the Committee. Additional meetings may be scheduled at the discretion of the Chair in consultation with staff.
- The quorum for regular meetings shall be in accordance with Section 74 of Administrative Order One, the Procedure of Council Administrative Order, Quorum of Committee.
- Any member of the Committee who fails to attend three (3) consecutive meetings, without having been excused by the Committee shall vacate the member's seat in accordance with subsection 3 of section 68 of Administrative Order One, the Procedure of Council Administrative Order, and subsection 1 of section 22 of the *Halifax Regional Municipality Charter*.
- All Planning Advisory Committee meetings shall be open to the public, or as allowed under Part VII Section 218 (1) of the *Halifax Regional Municipality Charter*.

7. Procedure

Meeting procedures shall be governed by the HRM Administrative Order One, the Procedure of Council Administrative Order, as it relates to Committee Procedures.

8. Remuneration

Remuneration shall be paid related to travel for attendance at meetings at rates established by Halifax Regional Municipality.

9. Resignation

A member may resign from the Committee at any time in accordance with Section 68 of Administrative Order One, the Procedure of Council Administrative Order, Vacating of Position on Committee.


