Environmental Scan of 2018 1st Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the first quarter of 2018 show an **increase** of +83 or by +8.69% compared to the first quarter in 2017.

<u>Drugs</u> in the first quarter of 2018 **increased** by +5 or by +6.58% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

In the first quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 44% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 17% and <u>Criminal Other</u> offences account for 39%.

First Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +55 or +13.78%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +8 or +42.11%.

Break and Enters **increased** by +16 or +24.62%.

Fraud incidents **increased** by +3 or +3.53%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +24 or +15.19%.

Robberies **increased** by +2 or +40%.

Homicides remained the same at 0.

Attempted Murders remained the same at 0.

Assaults **increased** by +22 or +14.86%.

Assaults accounted for 93% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2018.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -1 in the first quarter of 2018 or by -5.88%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in the first quarter of 2018.




Crimes Against Persons 1st Quarter Comparison








Crimes Against Property 1st Quarter Comparison












Assaults - Break & Enter - Theft Under January - March 2017/18

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 59% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in the 1^{st} quarter of 2018, the 1^{st} quarter of 2017 had a result of 57% and experienced a +20% **increase** in 2018 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 13% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2018 compared to 11% in 2017 and experienced a +29% **increase** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 22% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2018 compared to 26% in 2017.

Robberies accounted for 3% of the total <u>Persons Crime</u> in the 1^{st} quarter of 2018, the same in 2017 and experienced a +40% **increase** in 2018 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 76% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 1st quarter of 2018 compared to 63% in 2017 and experienced +51% **increase** in the 1st quarter of 2018 compared to the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 10% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in 2018 1st quarter compared to 15% in 2017 and experienced a -20% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 11% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 1st quarter 2018 compared to 18% in 2017 and experienced a -25% **decrease** in 2018 over the same period last year.

Theft Under \$5,000

Theft Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 69% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2018 compared to 74% in 2017 and experienced a +11% **increase** in 2018 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 30% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2018 compared to 26% in 2017 and experienced a +40% **increase** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods **decreased** by -7 incident or -50% in the 1st quarter of 2018 when compared to the same period last year.

Shoplifting Under \$5,000 experienced a +100% **increase** in the 1st quarter 2018 over the same period last year.

Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the first quarter of 2018 show an increase of +895 or by +20.49% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2018 increased by +8 or by +3.08% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

In the first quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 47% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 17% and <u>Criminal Other</u> offences account for 36%.

First Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increased by +424 or +20.73%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles increased by +8 or +12.12%.

Break and Enters increased by +24 or +9.84%.

Frauds increased by +48 or +14.24%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +208 or +29.42%.

Robberies increased by +14 or +35.90%.

Homicides increased by +1, with 2 incidents in the first quarter of 2018 compared to 1 in the first quarter of 2017.

Attempted Murders remain the same with 1 in the first quarter of 2018 and 2017.

Assaults increased by +189 or +28.99%.

Assaults accounted for 92% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2018.

Criminal Code Other

Includes solicitation, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons increased by +1 in the first quarter of 2018.

Solicitation offences showed no change with 5 in the first quarter of 2018 and 2017.

Please note offence statistic such as drugs and solicitation are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
