Subject: HUGA trail license or easement			
Motion for Transportation Standing Committee to Consider:			
That the Transportation Standing Committee request a staff report regarding the possible acquisition of a license or access easement in support of an active transportation trail along the aprons of the CN rail line from Inglis Street to the former Chester Spur (now the Chain of Lakes Trail).			
Reason			
The AT Priority Plan identifies HUGA Trail as a key "on ramp" for commuters from mainland Halifax to access the peninsula. The notional trail is proposed to run along the CN rail line.			
The staff report should include potential involvement of the Canadian Transportation Agency as a means for addressing and resolving dual public interest issues within the rail corridor and license or easement cost.
