

SCHEDULE "A"

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land on the northern boundary of the Halifax-Truro Highway, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake and stones at the northeast corner of lands now owned by James Eicing bounded on the western edge at the Truro-Halifax Highway;

THENCE running in a north easterly direction two hundred and eight feet to a stake and stones;

THENCE running in a north westerly direction two hundred and eight feet to a stake and stones;

THENCE running in a south westerly direction two hundred and eight feet to a stake and stones;

THENCE running joining the aforesaid James Eicings north line;

THENCE following this line two hundred and eight feet to place of beginning.
