Citizen Survey

Take the 2018 Citizen Survey by clicking here. By participating in the 2018 Citizen Survey, residents of the Halifax region will have the opportunity to let us know what their priorities are, what they think of municipal service delivery, and to help us make informed decisions to move toward a better future.

Now that the invitation-based survey has closed, we are opening the survey to all residents of the municipality. From August 20 to September 16, residents will be able to complete the survey online.

From July 30 to August 19, approximately 12,000 randomly-selected households received invitations to fill out the invitation-based survey online, in written form, or over the telephone. Both surveys include the same set of questions, though results will be tabulated separately. Results from the open survey will be used to provide additional information to Regional Council and municipal staff about the needs and expectations of our residents. PRA Inc., a national research firm is conducting the surveys on the municipality's behalf.

This rebate – funded federally through the Low Carbon Economy Fund and administered by Efficiency Nova Scotia – is available to Solar City participants, providing savings of up to \$10,000 on overall system costs
