The Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) is a new advisory committee to the Executive Standing Committee of Regional Council. There are 12 seats to be filled for the 2018-19 year, six of which are designated for people who identify with one or more of the designated communities.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

- Between 15-24 years of age
- Resident of the municipality
- Able to write, speak and have a good understanding of the English language
- Can commit to one full term that runs from September – May

STEP 1

CHECK FOR OPPORTUNITIES

STEP 2

COMPLETE AND SEND YOUR APPLICATION

STEP 3

THE REGIONAL COUNCIL SELECTION PROCESS

Your application will be reviewed and presented confidentially to the Executive Standing Committee and Regional Council. The selection process may involve an interview with relevant municipal staff and members of Regional Council. This process may take several months to complete.

STEP 4

READY TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Take Your Space in the Place and Get Ready to Make a Difference!

You will be contacted once the selected YAC members have been appointed. Municipal staff will be in touch with the appointees with information about orientation sessions, required training, and other necessary administrative items.

STEP 5

The municipality has designated at least 1 YAC seat for a youth from each of the following communities: Persons with Disabilities, Mi'kmaq, African Nova Scotian, Francophone/ Acadian community, Newcomer and LGBTQ2S. In addition, up to two youth from each Community Council area are designated a seat. The 12 seats total, will reflect a combination of these specifics.
