SUBJECT:	Proposed 2019 North West Planning Advisory Committee Meeting Schedule

<u>ORIGIN</u>

It is the practice for the North West Planning Advisory Committee (NWPAC) to adopt a schedule of meetings for the upcoming year.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Administrative Order 1, *Respecting the Procedures of the Council*, North West Planning Advisory Committee Terms of Reference, Section 6 *Meetings:*

The Planning Advisory Committee shall meet a least once monthly or as required to conduct the business of the Committee. Additional meetings may be scheduled at the discretion of the Chair in consultation with staff.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that North West Planning Advisory Committee approve the proposed 2018 meeting schedule as outlined in Attachment 1 to this report.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with Section 6 of the North West Planning Advisory Committee Terms of Reference, the NWPAC shall meet at least once monthly or as required to conduct the business of the Committee. The NWPAC meets the 1st Wednesday of each month, alternating between the BMO Centre Boardroom, 61 Gary Martin Drive, Bedford and the Sackville Heights Community Centre Silver and Gold Room, 45 Connolly Road, Middle Sackville, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

DISCUSSION

The proposed 2018 schedule provided as Attachment 1 of this report, proposes 10 regular meetings and takes into account statutory holidays, March Break, meetings of Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM), Nova Scotia Federation of Municipalities (NSFM), and Halifax Regional Council. The approval of this schedule will allow members of Council, staff and the public to be notified and plan in advance for meetings. The Chair of the NWPAC, with input from staff, has the authority to cancel a scheduled meeting should it be deemed necessary. A special meeting for a time sensitive matter may be called with appropriate notice, provided it is done in accordance with the HRM Charter and Administrative Order One.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget implications associated with the recommended course of action.

RISK CONSIDERATION

A delay in approval could result in additional delays for other HRM Committee meeting schedules, as the North West Planning Advisory Committee schedule may impact the timing of other Committee meeting times and dates.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The 2019 meeting schedule for the NWPAC, once adopted, is posted to the HRM calendar at Halifax.ca to enable members of the public and media to have access to the meeting schedule, agendas and reports.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no environmental implications associated with the recommended course of action.

ALTERNATIVES

The NWPAC may recommend and/or adjust the proposed 2019 meeting schedule as they see fit.
