

# SCHEDULE "A"

ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the north side of Rufus Street, off the west side of Dutch Village Road, in the County of Halifax, Province of Nova Scotia, as shown in the plan of Brookdale Subdivision, filed in the Registry of Deeds at Halifax on July 17th, 1937, being Plan No. 392 and more particularly described as follows, that is to say:-

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Rufus Street, at the south-east corner of Lot No. 14;

THENCE Northerly along the eastern boundary of Lot No. 14 Eighty-four (84) feet more or less to a stone wall dividing this subdivision from the property immediately north of same, now occupied by one William Keeler;

THENCE easterly along the Keeler boundary Fifty (50) feet, more or less to the north-west corner of Lot No. 12;

THENCE southerly along the western boundary of Lot No. 12, Eighty-six (86) feet, more or less to Rufus Street;

THENCE westerly along Rufus Street, Fifty (50) feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, being Lot No. 13, Section "A", as shown on said plan.
