Community Art Program

The Community Art Program supports community art projects by partnering with community groups, organizations, artists and individuals to offer impactful projects in their community. All art forms, including visual arts, music, theatre, dance and writing are invited to apply. Successful applicants will partner with HRM and have access to gathering space in HRM Recreation centers if needed, free digital promotion and printed posters, and will have access to up to \$4,000 of support funding to contribute towards the budget.

Applications will be evaluated on its ability to achieve the following aspects:

- 1. The project brings community together in a meaningful way.
- 2. The project includes a professional artist.
- 3. Participation is open and inclusive (does not only serve a club or closed member group).
- 4. There is an installation, show or performance at the end of the project that is freely accessible and promoted to the wider public.
- 5. The budget is detailed and clear.

There is added interest in supporting projects that target youth, seniors, newcomers, or other marginalized communities. Projects are not limited to these groups exclusively.

Quality projects often come with a larger price tag than the support funding offered through this program. Applicants are encouraged to matching funds or in-kind support through other sources.

Applicants often benefit from contacting their area Community Developer in before they apply to talk through their vision. *Contact information for your area can be found at the bottom of page 5.*

Applications are received March to September on a first-come, first-served basis.
