Motion for Council to Consider:	
That Halifax Regional Council approve an exemption for a district capital grant in the amount of \$5000.00 to purchase new ultrasound equipment for the Musquodoboit Valley Memorial Hospital.	
Reason:	
This request is not eligible through the District Capital Grants Program as the ultrasound equipment is for a Provincial Hospital. The current equipment used at Musquodoboit Valley Memorial Hospital is dated and in need or replacement. This equipment is required to properly treat patients and provide them with quicker diagnosis, especially those that are unable to travel.
