- Agendas set out the order of each item to be discussed at a meeting. You can find agendas online at *Halifax.ca*, one week before the meeting date. It will include links to presentations, staff reports and recommendations. The minutes, or the public record of the meeting, are published online as well.

• Watch Council & Committee Meetings in person or online

- Meetings of Regional Council take place at City Hall. All meetings are open to the public and streamed online. You can access past recordings online. In camera or private meetings are exempt.

Freedom of Information Requests

 Visit the Routine Disclosure Plans for each department to see if the information you are seeking is listed – if so, you can submit a disclosure request to access the information. (\$5 application fee for non-personal info)

• Municipal Archives

- Contact the archives, go online or visit in person to access municipal records documenting the history of the Halifax Region.

 - Sign or present Petitions

Speak at a Council or Committee Meeting

- Presentations & Delegations to Council
- Address Council at a Public Hearing
- PAC hosted Public Information Meetings

 - Contact your Councillor and the Mayor
 - Volunteer on Boards & Committees of Council
 - Shape Your City Halifax
 - Elections: Become a Candidate, Work on Polling Day, Vote!







HRM Voter Turnout by Level of government (%)








Turnout in last municipal elections for select cities in each region



Who can vote?

- Canadian citizen, 18 years of age by advance polling day
- Resident of Nova Scotia for six months prior to advance polling day
- Resident of HRM immediately before advance polling day

How can you vote?

- In person at polling location
- Online or by phone!



Accessibility

- We work to ensure polling locations are physically accessible
- Online voting increases accessibility for those who can not make it to a physical location
- Hearing and visual impairments supported by online and telephone voting



- How should the candidate materials be presented to appeal to youth – should there be a designated youth candidate information session? If yes, what should it look like?
- How important are images and representation of youth images in materials?
- What are some tactics/strategies/platforms that could be used to get more Youth at the polls?








Civics Education
