Subject: Crichton Avenue Candidate Bike Route	
That the Transportation Standing Committee request a staff report on adding Crichton Avenue in Dartmouth to the candidate bike routes identified in the Active Transportation Priorities Plan. Reason: Crichton Avenue runs from Ochterloney Street to Mic Mac Mall and is a major connecting street in Dartmouth linking residential areas to commercial services, Downtown Dartmouth, active transportation infrastructure, and transit. The geography in the area is quite constrained by Lake Banook and Brightwood Golf Course, making Crichton Avenue, effectively, the only route along the north side of Lake Banook. The street isn't part of the IMP's Minimum Grid and isn't identified as a candidate route in the Active Transportation Priorities Plan. Given Crichton Avenue's significance in Dartmouth's street network and that no other connections were identified for the Crichton Park, it should be considered as a possible bike route.
