



VEHICLE / PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS

HRM: September 2019

DISCLAIMER: All figures presented in this report reflect the information held on HRP systems at the time of data extraction and are subject to change without notice.

Summary

- 159 vehicle/pedestrian/bicycle collisions were **reported** in January- September 2019, in Halifax Regional Municipality.
- Of these collisions, 54 involved a bicycle/scooter/skateboard.
- The remaining 105 incidents were strictly vehicle/pedestrian collisions, with 109 pedestrian victims.
- TOTAL VEHICLE/PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS IN HRM: 105
- TOTAL VEHICLE/PEDESTRIAN VICTIMS IN HRM: 109
- TOTAL PEDESTRIAN FATALITIES IN HRM: 3
- TOTAL VEHICLE/PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS IN HRM IN SEPTEMBER 2019: 5

Note:

- This report presents strictly vehicle/pedestrian collisions and excludes those incidents involving bicycles.
- Scooters/skateboards are recorded under bicycles for purposes of this report.
- Several months in 2019 involved incidents with two pedestrian victims.



Trends


Vehicle/pedestrian collisions saw a slight decrease in September 2019 over the previous month. It should be noted, however, that incidents decreased by 15 when compared to September of 2018.

RCMP Halifax District


The number of incidents in January- September has decreased compared to 2018. In 2018 there were 16 incidents, and so far this year there have been 11 incidents reported.


HRM

There have been 27 less collisions reported in 2019 compared to the same time period in 2018.











Collision Types

The same percentage of vehicle/pedestrian collisions took place in crosswalks in 2018 when compared to 2019.

So far in 2019, almost half of incidents (48%), involved vehicles driving straight.

Injuries

75 or 68.75% of the 109 pedestrian victims experienced either no injury or minor injury in January-September of 2019.


There has been 3 pedestrian fatalities thus far in HRM in 2019.

No driver injuries were reported due to collision with pedestrian.


Pedestrian Characteristics

Driver Characteristics


Males accounted for 45 or 58% of drivers involved in vehicle pedestrian collisions in 2019.

Peak Collision Times

In January-September 2019, peak time for collisions was 3pm, while peak day for collisions was Tuesday.



Weather & Lighting Conditions

69 or 75% of the reported motor vehicle pedestrian collisions in January-September 2019 occurred during clear and/or sunny weather conditions.

There were 17 collisions which took place during overcast or rain and/or foggy conditions.

70 or 76% of the reported collisions took place during daylight.

59 or 64% of the reported collisions took place during daylight with clear and/or sunny weather conditions.

Note: excludes 13 cases where weather conditions are unknown
