Quarterly report Market view

- The market saw 118,086 sq. ft. of industrial new supply between two buildings come online this quarter.
- The Halifax industrial market continues to tighten at an impressive rate, as the market recorded over 100,000 sq. ft of positive net absorption for the second straight quarter...this marks the tenth straight quarter that the rate has decreased.
- Average asking net rents climbed \$0.02 p.s.f. quarter-over-quarter to \$8.18 p.s.f.
- Market Outlook KingSett Capital Inc. purchased Dream Industrial's 2.7 million sq. ft. Maritime portfolio, giving KingSett Capital Inc. the largest portfolio in the entire Halifax industrial market.

This deal was shortly followed by another major deal, as ProREIT purchased Greystone's portfolio consisting of five properties and just over 350,000 sq. ft. of industrial space.

Up and running - the Holiday Inn Express & Suites located on John Savage Ave. in City of Lakes park is open - features restaurant, pool and fitness facilities, and just around the corner from the RBC sport centre and Dartmouth Crossing retail.



MacFarlands Truck Utility Division is now complete, located at 409 Higney Ave. in Burnside, just behind the MacFarlands Industrial location on Cutler Ave.



Construction is complete for this new multi-tenant industrial warehouse facility located at 96 Trider Court in Burnside park, purchased by North Ridge Holdings.



Progress continues on Wilkinson Equities' third building as part of its Wilkinson Project of multi-tenant warehousing units in Burnside, at what will be civic 315.

This location on Wilkinson Ave. in Burnside, consisting of Lots 12-5-03 A & B and comprises 296,763 sq. ft., was purchased by Somerled ECI GP Management Inc. where it intends to develop a transport trucking sales, service and repair facility and cardlock refueling station.



Ground has broke at this lot on Higney Ave. in Burnside, consisting of 138,702 sq. ft. and purchased by 3326341 Nova Scotia Ltd. to construct a Maaco auto body repair facility.



Murlee Holdings Limited purchased this lot on Higney Ave. in Burnside, a consolidation of Lots 1292/3/4, for a total of 585,237 sq. ft. to develop a warehouse/distribution centre for home furnishings/appliances/electronics, and repairs.
